**Directions to Yolo Bypass Wildlife Area Resource Center:**

**From San Francisco take I-80 East and exit at Mace Blvd. Turn left at the end of the off-ramp (Chiles Road). Go straight through the next light and travel approximately 2 miles, and turn right into the Yolo Bypass Wildlife area parking lot.**

**From Sacramento take I-80 West. After crossing the Yolo Bypass causeway take the first exit (County Road 32A). Turn right at the end of the off-ramp (at the stop sign) and loop under the freeway. Go about 2 miles along the frontage road and turn left into the Yolo Bypass Wildlife Area parking lot.**
